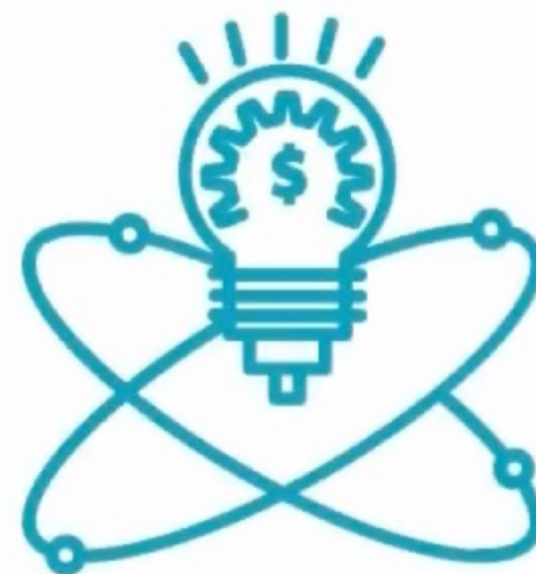

NC BEC ECOSYSTEM Grant

- Opportunity for NC-based entrepreneur support organizations and institutions that support Black entrepreneurs
- NOT for entrepreneurs, startups, or small businesses
- NOT for consulting projects
- Grants up to \$50,000; anticipate awarding 6 grants
 - Education and training (accelerator) programs
 - Coaching and mentoring
 - Entrepreneurship competitions, demo days, hackathons
 - Assistance for hiring, marketing and sales, product development, etc.
 - NC IDEA does not allow grants to include indirect overhead costs

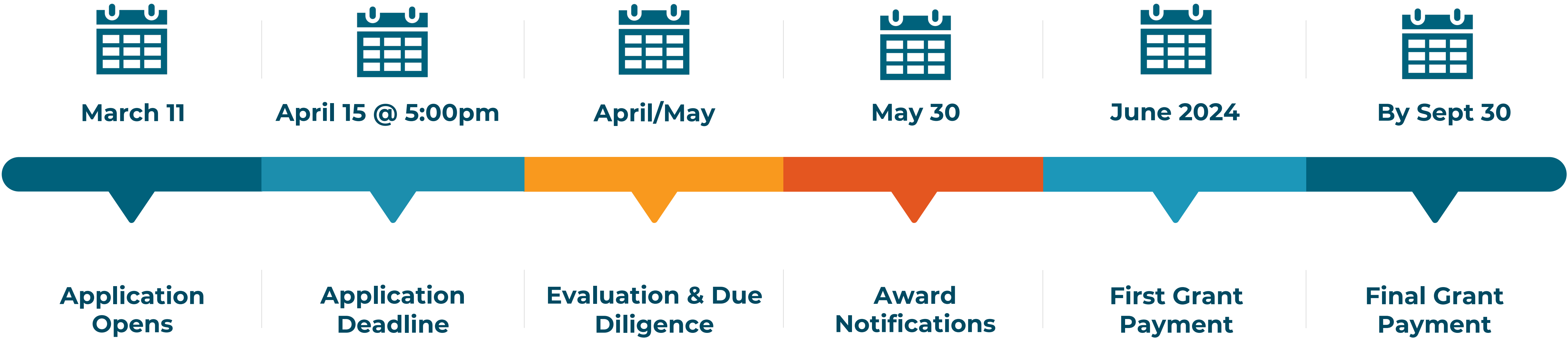
Eligibility Criteria

- 100% of grant dollars must be allocated toward specific programs and activities serving Black entrepreneurs
- Priority consideration will be given to organizations that:
 - Are Black-led and reflective of the community being served
 - Have demonstratable intent to focus grant activities and initiatives toward Black female founders
 - Are actively working in rural and/or economically distressed counties
- Ineligible applicants include:
 - Entrepreneurs, startups, or small businesses
 - Endowments, capital campaigns or other fundraising events
 - Lobbying organizations, political parties, or labor organizations
 - Individuals

Evaluation Criteria

- Alignment
- Ability to Execute
- Outcomes & Metrics
- Sustainability
- Leverage
- Timing

NC BEC ECOSYSTEM Timeline



- Adhere to character counts; but be clear and concise
- Questions include proposed project, team, existing programs, budget, outcomes and metrics, impact
- Recommend using offline application template
- Have others review before submitting
- Watch for spelling and grammar errors
- Application MUST be submitted online – save often
- Do not log in at same time on different devices/browsers
- Do NOT wait until the last minute to submit!
