

Company Types Not Eligible for NC IDEA MICRO and SEED

Company Types Not Eligible for NC IDEA MICRO and SEED Companies with high capital requirements and a long runway to commercialization, such as pharmaceutical companies, are not eligible. Other companies that are considered out of scope and not eligible for grant funding include:

- Construction companies
- Consulting practices or agencies
- Distributors
- Event venue and management companies
- Franchises
- Licensing only business models
- Lifestyle companies
- Local, service-oriented small businesses (i.e. restaurants, retail stores, catering, cleaning companies, or any business whose model is not designed to scale beyond a local or regional service area)
- Not-for-profits
- Podcasts
- Resellers
- Traditional media companies
- Traditional publishing companies
- Traditional rental companies
- Traditional staffing agencies
- Training companies
- Trucking, hauling, and freight companies
- TV/film production companies
- YouTube/Twitch/Social Media communities

Also excluded are businesses that are illegal in NC, even if legal in other states or countries.
